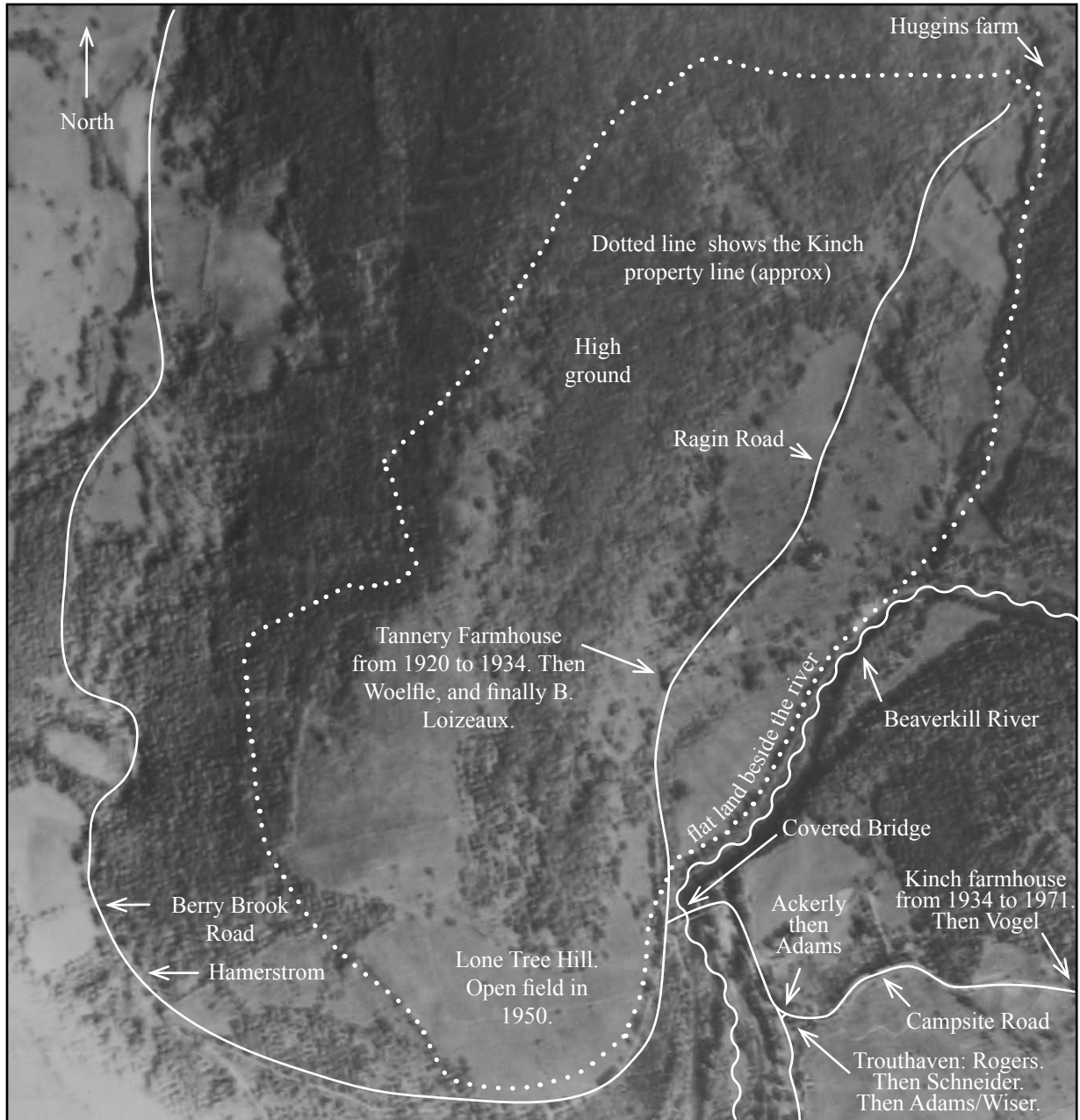


AERIAL VIEW OF BEVERKILL ABOUT 1950



Kinch Family Holdings on the West Side of the Beaverkill

The dotted line outlines the Kinch holdings; the wavy line shows the river itself; solid lines mark the roads. This map shows the considerable acreage owned by Frank Kinch on the west side of the Beaverkill. Starting at the top of Ragin Road near the Huggins farm, the Kinch property ran south joining the river above the Covered Bridge, then along the river to the Covered Bridge, then along Berry Brook Road for a short way, and back over the ridge behind today's Hamerstrom house. These holdings included both high ground (Lone Tree Hill and most of the adjacent hills) and low (the flats along the river), totalling some 300+ acres of mixed woods, farm and pastureland.
